

Zero Tolerance Policy –

message from our Governing Body

Due to occasional aggression or abuse towards staff from parents/carers, the Governing Body have asked me to highlight that they have a zero tolerance policy towards this in school and it may result in written reminders or, in extreme cases, a ban from school premises.

Staff at Hanging Heaton CE (VC) J&I School work very hard and care a great deal about the wellbeing and learning of all of our children and in order to achieve this, we aim to work in partnership with parents and have an open door policy.

We are always willing to help resolve a situation where parents are polite and calm.

Water Bottles in school

Please note: children are allowed to bring water bottles in order that they have access to water throughout the day. These water bottles should contain **water only** (not flavoured or carbonated please, nor with squash). Research shows that:-

- Drinking adequate amounts of water regularly throughout the day can protect health and contribute to well-being.
- Drinking adequate amounts of water can help prevent a range of short and long-term health problems from headaches, bladder, kidney and bowel problems to cancer.
- Water has none of the health problems associated with drinks containing sugar, additives, sweeteners or acids.

PE lessons – we are fortunate to be able to stretch our sports premium to allow 2 hours of coaching per week for all classes. A couple of notes:-

- Should children not be able to do PE, we require medical evidence from a Doctor
- Children will need to wear PE kit and remove earrings during lessons
