


<p>ENGLISH We will study techniques used to persuade and incorporate these into our sales pitches and marketing campaign as part of the Fiver Challenge. We will also develop our speaking and listening skills in presentations. We will study different forms of poetry (narrative, free-verse and image) and also get to grips with the key features of fiction and non-fiction genres. We will also develop our spelling, punctuation and grammar vocabulary.</p>	<p>MATHS We will design and carry out market research questionnaires and analyse and reflect on our findings, presenting data in graphs and charts and making statements. We will also get to grips with our understanding of shape (2D and 3D), volume and capacity. We will become succinct in explaining reasoning for the methods we choose and become more fluent in number facts and relationships.</p>	<p>SCIENCE This half term our science topic will be electricity. We will construct simple circuits and draw them and find out which materials are the best electrical conductors. We will use this information to make switches. We will also find what happens to a bulb's brightness when circuits are changed and research Benjamin Franklin, Michael Faraday and Thomas Edison.</p>	<p>RE We will look at examples of 'words of wisdom' from Sikhs, Christians and Muslims to consider sources of guidance or wisdom in our own lives. Stories and sayings from the religions are used for the opportunity they provide to reflect upon our own values and experiences. We will use a range of learning strategies such as stilling, guided story and guided reflection.</p>	<p>FIVER CHALLENGE Class 4 will work in small groups to set-up a mini business which can provide a product or a service to its customers and make as much profit as possible. Each business will receive a £5 pledge to help get started and buy any materials / resources that are required. As part of the challenge, pupils will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • conduct market research and reflect on their findings • devise a business plan • prepare and present a sales pitch • plan budget and finances • design and make their product • consider how they will market their product/service • sell their product for a profit <p>Taking part in the Fiver Challenge will: Be fun!
