All our children are special



- We monitor children's progress continually.
- Children develop at different rates.
- Don't worry!
- Special Educational Needs Co-ordinator (SENCo) in school.
- Short term intervention support sometimes is required.

What you can do to help!

- Encourage children to draw, paint etc
- Show children your writing, shopping lists, things to do, birthday cards, let them mimic you.
- Make scrap books, write postcards, party invitations.
- Develop fine motor skills by cutting, sewing, dot-to-dots etc.
- Point out familiar letters in signs, registration plates.
- When you talk about letters to your child, remember to use the letter sounds: **a buh cuh duh e**

What you can do to help!

- Talk to them about whatever they are doing.
- Play I Spy when out.
- Go to the library and read to them.
- Encourage them to sort the washing, pair socks, count...anything!
- Encourage their love of learning.
