The focus of our worship will be centred on Values for Life - a Church of England resource for worship. Specific information can be found in the Values for Life file (kept in the paper store). The rota will be as follows:

- Monday led by Janet Potter introducing the value.
- Tuesday Staff led worship scripted from Values for Life
- Wednesday Talk Worship led by Sue Brooke-Mawson on the same theme.
- Thursday Worship led by visitor, Whoosh Worship (pupils) or Team Worship (Ambassadors).
- Friday Celebration worship led by Janet Potter where awards are aligned to Christian Values.

Of the 18 Christian Values included in the C of E resource initial consultations concluded that all values were relevant and that at different times we need to focus on different ones. As a result, we cover all values throughout school with the school's vision of 'Let all that you do be done in love' - 1 Corinthians 16:14 woven throughout and underpinning all that we do. This means we cover 6 per year which leaves a rolling programme of a three-year cycle.

Core values for 2023-2024 are: Hope, Service, Humility, Justice, Generosity and Perseverance.

Wherever possible visitors to be invited to share worship half termly: Father Jonathan, Rev Nick and Mrs Exley.
