The focus of our worship will be centred on Values for Life a Church of England resource for worship. Specific information can be found in the Values for Life file (kept in the paper store). The rota will be as follows:

- Monday - led by Janet Potter - introducing the value.

- Wednesday - Talk Worship led by Sue Brooke-Mawson - on the same theme.
- Thursday - Worship led by visitor, Whoosh or Pupil Led Worship (pupils), Team Worship (Ambassadors) or other pupil led worship.
- Friday - Celebration worship - led by Janet Potter where awards are aligned to Christian Values.
