

Country Project

Over the holidays I would like you to research any country of your choice. It could be a country you already know and have even visited or it could be a country you know very little about and would like to learn more about! How you present the project is entirely up to you. It could be a PowerPoint, posters, leaflets or items you have made - be as creative as you like! I have asked some questions below that might give you a starting point for your project. You can complete as many or as little of these questions as you like and you might have your own ideas! Our first topic when we return to school in September is on Ancient Egypt so it might be that you want to find out about Egypt. When we come back to school in September we will present these to the rest of the class!

Geography

Where is the country located? Are there any neighbouring countries? Which ocean/sea is it located in? Which continent is it in? How long does it take to get there?

What mountains and rivers does it have? Which is the tallest and longest? Does it have any volcanoes? Has it had any natural disasters? Does it have any famous landmarks?

What famous cities does it have?

What type of weather does it have? How is that different to the weather in the UK? Does it have extreme weather conditions?

What does its flag look like? Why does it look like that? Where does it come from?

What is its population size and makeup?

What type of government does it have?

What languages are spoken?

What are houses like?

What does a stamp look like from that country?

What money does it use? Is it a rich or poor country?

What is school like? How is it similar/different from the UK?

Does it have tourist areas? What are they like?

History

Does it have any famous leaders? Why are they famous? What did they do that was great?

Do any celebrities come from your country of choice? What are they famous for? Have they done anything to support their country?

Have there been any wars?

What music is popular? How has this changed? Are there any instruments that come from your country?

What famous landmarks does it have? When were they built? Who by? Why were they built? Why are they important?

Do they have a king/queen? Have they ever had a king or queen?

Does it have any important dates? You might want to include a time line

What past times do people have?

Science

Do any famous scientists come from your country?

What are they famous for? What did they discover? What can we learn from them?

Have any life changing experiments taken place in your country of choice?

Which animals live in your country? What is the habitat like?

What is the main religion of your country? Is that similar or different to the UK?

Do they have any religious festivals? How do they celebrate them?

Which god/gods do they believe in? Has this changed over time?

If your country celebrates Christmas/Easter how do they celebrate them? Do they have different traditions to the UK?
