































Basic information


- Children will continue to enter school in their classes for registration.

- PE will be on Wednesdays






























Structure of the morning

11:00 - 12:00 English































Structure of the afternoon

1:30-3:00:


- PE 1 hour and half session a week led by sports specialists. Please make sure kits are in school.

Work will be differentiated accordingly and be based around a different topic each half term
























Weekly Homework

- Computing homework- will be set every Monday to be returned on the following Monday.






















Strong emphasis on reading across school.


Reading for pleasure will significantly impact upon your child's confidence in reading and their achievement in reading overall (and across the wider curriculum)

Children will bring a reading book home daily (Changed on Friday)

Reading Challenge cards- can you read the books on the card?

Comprehension to be completed once a week in school.

Read, Lead, Succeed sessions- We will be looking at a book as a class. Our first book is the 'Accidental Prime Minister Returns by Tom Mclaughlin.

































Target Setting


- Your child will have set targets for Maths,
 Writing, Reading and Attitude to learning each half term.
- These will be agreed with your child following discussion at the start of each half term.
- These will be shared with yourselves, who will have opportunity to comment on and offer support at home.
- Children and teachers will assess progress each half term and once again share details with parents.






























Maths- Helping with fluency

- To improve your child's math skills it is important to practise as much as possible.
- Having a solid foundation in key areas such as times tables and mental addition and subtraction will give your child the best chance to improve.
- Year 4 children will take a times table check in June on the computer. Children will have 6 seconds to answer a question- This means practise is essential! (Year 5 need to be accessing TT Rockstars too!)



































Behaviour System

- Stage 1 Name recorded on board as a warning
- Stage 2 Mark recorded next to name on board as final warning
- Stage 3 Time out in class
- Stage 4 Time out in alternative class
- Stage 5 Time out at playtime with reflection sheet
- Stage 6 Time out at lunchtime
- Stage 7 Senior leader intervention (could result in parental engagement and/or exclusion)


EXAMPLES OF ACTIONS	CONSEQUENCES to start at
Disruptive behaviour in class	Stage 1
Misbehaviour at playtime	Stage 5
Misbehaviour at lunchtime	Stage 6
Racism or bullying	Stage 7
Intentional violence to another child or adult	Stage 7

























 Stamps to be given out based on effort-Bronze, Silver, Gold and Platinum certificates!


 Anyone reading 7 times a week will be able to choose a prize from the treasure chest in class.
















