Use of COVID Catch Up Premium

Allocation Details: £10,720

One to one intervention - Maths: 7 places secured on remote one to one online Maths tuition offered as part of the National Tutoring Programme. This commenced in January 2021 for a period of 24 weeks. All children included within these sessions are in receipt of Pupil Premium. Total cost £1,760

Impact: Pupil voice indicates a much-improved confidence around maths. Analysis of direct tutoring indicates that on average students were secure in 84% of the topics that they were introduced to and with an enjoyment rating by the pupils involved of an average of 4.4/5. Only one child (who was ill at the time of testing) did not either maintain or improve past performance.

Group Teaching and learning Intervention: Half day a week qualified teacher to work with Upper Key Stage 2 on filling the gap interventions in English. Activities to be focused on missing gaps in education identified as a result of Quality First Teaching. Children in these sessions will include all those who are in receipt of Pupil Premium as well as additional children who have also been detrimentally impacted by COVID 19. Total cost £5,200

Impact: Pupil voice was very positive with pupils reporting an increased confidence in their literacy. All pupils made progress in reading either achieving end of year expectations or getting closer to it, with the exception of one child who for medical reasons missed a lot of schooling.

The original plan was to also secure remote literacy support. However, the children who would have been identified to be part of this support were already accessing one of the initiatives above and the small numbers involved precluded many tutoring packages. Therefore, the total remaining from budget - £3,760 carried forward to 2020/21 Pupil Premium budget to cover shortfall in expenditure over budget.
