## Protected Characteristics within the curriculum.

No form of discrimination is tolerated at Hanging Heaton C of E (VC) J & I School. We adopt an Everyone is Equal policy irrespective of any characteristics which may or may not be protected. We do however both teach about the protected characteristics and how it is important to show respect to people in these groups, but more importantly, make sure that we show we understand these characteristics by making sure they underpin everything we do.

We address this in several ways through our carefully timetabled worship sessions, through specific curriculum areas of PSHCE and RE and learn about these characteristics in an age appropriate way. During their time at Hanging Heaton, children cover all the major world religions. These are taught with the understanding that we celebrate and respect all religions and their principles. Different aspects of Christianity are taught in each year. Our school worship calendar also includes both visitors from other religions and also the opportunity to hear stories from other religions.
