Can you tell the story by using a storyboard and get all the characters appearing in the right order?	If you could choose a character behind the door, who would you choose? Draw a picture as big as you can and describe the character in as many sentences as you can.	Today we will be adding labels to the different parts of our character. A label gives the reader extra written information. Label different <u>body parts</u> of the character, e.g. feet, head, arms. Label different parts <u>attached</u> to character, e.g. shoes, hat, wand. This time try using adjectives (describing words) within the label, e.g. <i>beautiful red shoes</i> . <b>Maths</b> 	There are three baskets, a brown one, a red one and a pink one, holding a total of ten eggs. The Brown basket has one more egg in it than the Red basket. The Red basket has three fewer eggs than the Pink basket. How many eggs are in each basket? Draw and colour some baskets and see if you can work it out so it all makes sense, use counters or coins as eggs. 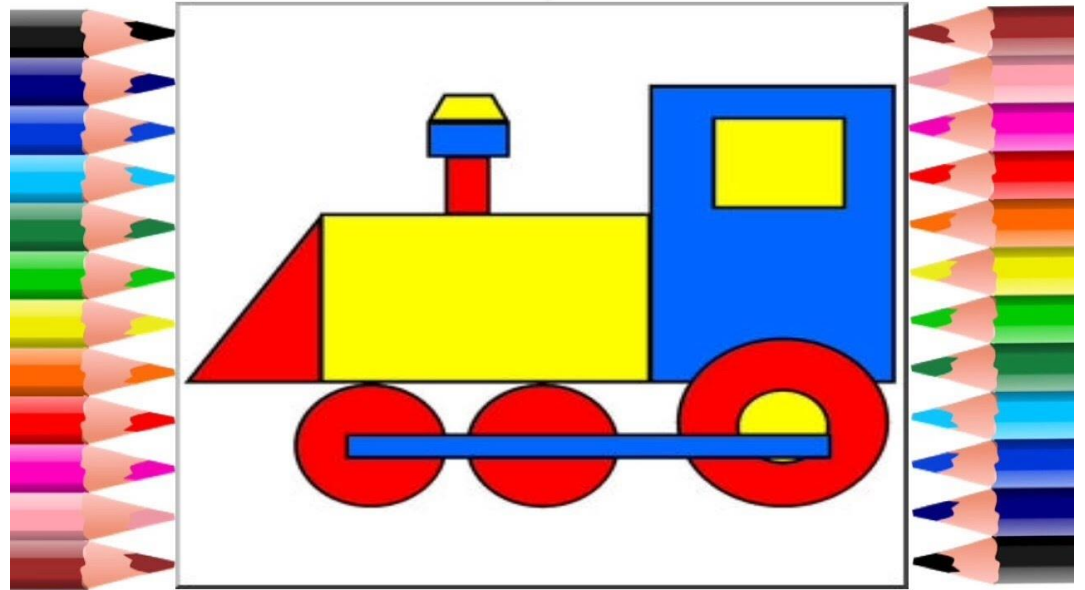
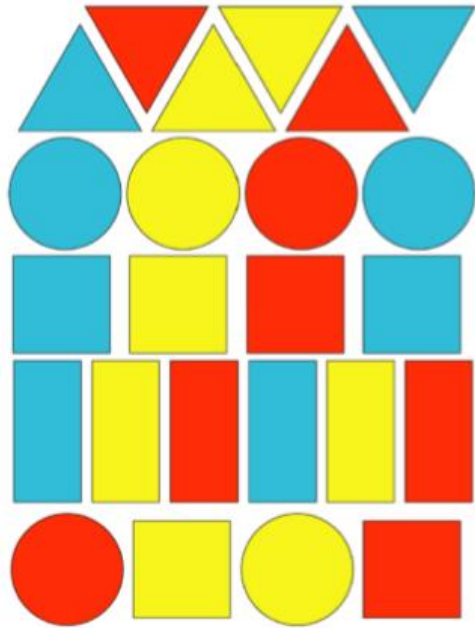
