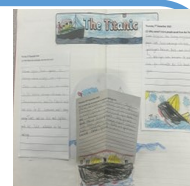
In maths we learned about addition and subtraction across 10. We had some practical lessons to find out why do we need to do exchange and regrouping arithmetic and lots of problem solving.

In history we learned about the reasons of sinking of the unsinkable Titanic. We discussed the possible reasons and also we learned how to make these voyages safer and safer these days.



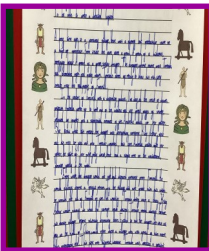
Class 3

Class 3 have had an action packed half term. In English, we have studied myths and legends and have learnt about limericks. We have become more confident with multiplication and division in our maths lessons and in Geography we learnt about megacities (cities with populations over 10 million people!). We also looked at the advantages and disadvantages of living in cities. Our Science topic was States of Matter and we have learnt about solids, liquids and gases, conducting experiments to learn more about evaporation. In RE, we learnt about celebrations in different faiths and also had the opportunity to go on a spiritual journey when we had visitors from Hand to Mouth. We also loved our school trip to This Green Moon where we did lots of outdoor learning. We role played becoming a tribe, appointing leaders, practising fire lighting, sharpening stones and we even got to pretend to be hunter gatherers.



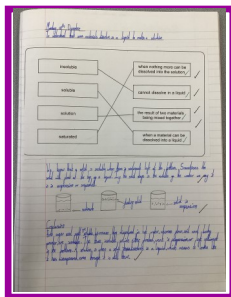
Class 5

In class 5 Maths lessons, year 5 pupils, have been learning long multiplication and division. Year 6 pupils have been completing work on ratio and proportion before moving on to algebra.



We have learnt about the features of Legends in Literacy and have written some of our own.

In Science, we looked at the topic of 'Materials', focusing mainly on solids, liquids and gases. We did work on thermal insulators, and carried out an investigation on this. Finally, we learnt about magnetic materials.



Geography lessons were based on the topic of 'Rivers', learning about the longest and most famous rivers around the world. We learnt about the Little Ice Age and what happened to the River Thames during this period of time. We came up with our own ideas about what entertainment there would be if the Thames froze over today.



In Art, we have been working on the art skill Chiaroscuro. We explored different techniques to make a Mayan word look like it had been carved out of stone.

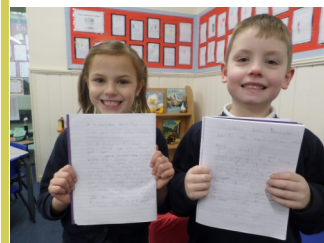
In maths, reception have learnt about prepositional language to describe and direct.
