

Covid update

Again we have no cases in school with a small number of children and families self-isolating due to symptoms but testing negative. Families planning to form a Christmas bubble of 3 households are advised to avoid contact with others for 2 weeks leading up to

Christmas and we are now within that time frame. Professor Chris Witty our Chief Medical Officer is quite clear that this is a very risky period and that even though we can form this

bubble, it doesn't mean that we should. I am particularly concerned as to the effect that this will have on cases in school and urge people to consider keeping everyone as safe as possible in the current climate.

We await updated news on Wednesday 16th December as to which tier we will be in during the Christmas period and I urge everyone to keep up to date with this and follow the guidance for this tier, whatever it may be.

May I remind all parents/carers that messages should be passed on by ringing school on the above telephone number so that these can be passed on to classes before children come into school and

we are not therefore breaking our bubble procedures. Colleagues are at the gate on a morning to support and welcome

children coming into school. I sincerely hope that we continue to be able to keep all of our pods open over the next week and beyond so that no one will have to self-isolate over the Christmas period.

This relies on everyone following the current guidance to keep us safe.
