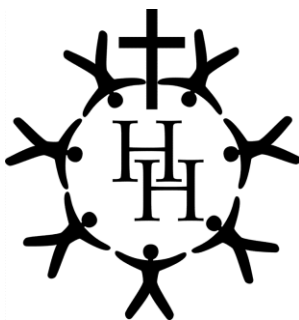

## **Key Stage 1 Fruit**

## **PE Kits**

I did ask that you bear with us as we review and amend our plans over the coming weeks to ensure things run more smoothly. May I ask please that children come to school on PE days in PE kit Starting week beginning 14<sup>th</sup> September, PE will take place on the following days:-

Class 1 – Tuesday

Class 2 – Monday

Class 3 – Thursday

Class 4 – Wednesday

Class 5 - Friday

On their class day, they will need to wear their PE t-shirt with school jumper over the top, joggers (preferably dark coloured), trainers for outdoor use and a waterproof coat or jacket suitable for the weather forecast.

These can then be laundered for the following week rather than being left in school.
