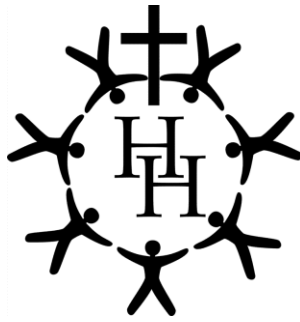

Flu Vaccinations

Our flu vaccinations will take place next Wednesday 18th November. Permission slips should have been sent back to school for these.

This year, to support social distancing and limited visitors in school, these are taking place in the church hall throughout the day.

For this day only, **parents of children in Class 1 should drop their children off between 8.40 and 8.50 at the Church hall** where Miss Brook and Mrs Ryder will be waiting for them. Classes 2-5 should be dropped off as usual at the school gate.

Any children not in school next Wednesday, will be contacted separately to rearrange so should not go to their GP. Thank you for your support.
