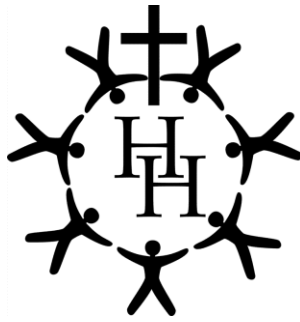

Covid Update

End of the day collection from school

May I remind all our community members who are collecting at the end of the day please:

- School finishes at 3pm and staff may not let children leave before this so please do not encourage children through the window to move before this time.
- Please wear masks, it is not good enough to simply cover the mouth with an item of clothing. I think we are all more than used to regularly carrying masks with us by now.
- Remain at a social distance of at least 2m from people who live in other households.
- Keep children closely supervised and by your side. They should not be running on the grass banking or playing on the tyres.
- Leave the vicinity of school immediately on collecting your child(ren) to prevent congestion.

I am becoming increasingly concerned by groups of parents chatting and the lack of social distancing and how this may affect school being fully open.
