

Lateral flow tests for staff

It is important we all try to keep as safe as possible. To this end, staff in school are strongly recommended to take lateral flow tests twice weekly which may result in emergency short term closure of pods due to staff shortages. We will make every attempt to limit this and thank you for your patience.

Procedures for closure of pods

Just like during Autumn term, if we have a positive case in one of our pods, we will have to close the whole pod and all adults and children within the pod will need to self isolate for 10 days following contact with the infected individual. It is important that all families carefully follow the rules, in spirit as well as in law.

Once again the guidance asks us to limit the spread in school by reducing contacts rather than distancing. The more we all do that, outside of school as well as inside, the safer we will be. Let's all work together, just like last term, to keep our school fully open as much as possible. Thank you for your co-operation.

PE days changing

Due to operational changes in school, we have had to alter certain class PE days until Easter at the earliest. PE days from 8th March until the 26th March will be:-

- Monday Class 4
- Tuesday Class 1
- Wednesday Class 3
- Thursday Class 2
- Friday Class 5.

Children should come in PE uniform on these days. As before, every attempt will be made to do PE outdoors so please take note of the weather forecast!
