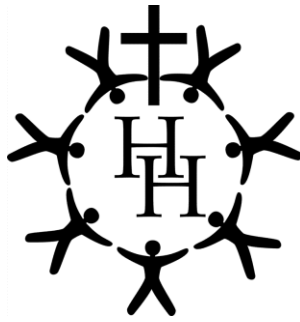

Covid Update

It is alarming to consider that it is now over a year since coronavirus started to seriously affect our lives. Despite apparent high rates local to school, thankfully we have had no confirmed cases since fully reopening on the 8th March.

From Monday 29th March, there are some further relaxations to lockdown rules and these are:

- 6 people (Rule of 6) OR 2 households can meet up **outdoors only** including in private gardens,
- Outdoor sports facilities will be allowed to reopen and people will be able to participate in formally organised outdoor sports,
- The 'stay at home' rule will be modified to 'stay local'. People should continue to work from home where they can and minimise the number of journeys they make where possible, avoiding travel at the busiest times and routes.

Hopefully these rules will allow our children and families to enjoy further freedoms over the Easter break, play and meet up with others for the first time really since early January.

Please continue to follow the rules and exercise patience in these challenging times, however difficult that may be, so that we can all have more to look forward to in the weeks and months ahead.
