

## Arrangements for Classes and Teachers 2021-2022

From September, the following arrangements for classes will be in place:-

- Class 1 Miss Wilson Mixed Reception/Year 1
- Class 2 Mrs McGee Mixed Year 1/Year 2
- Class 3 Miss Nash Mixed Year 3/Year 4
- Class 4 Mr Conway Mixed Year 4/Year 5
- Class 5 Mrs Norton and Mrs Limon Year 6
- Mrs Brooke-Mawson will cover Planning, Preparation and Assessment time for teaching staff and be instrumental in supporting our Recovery and Catch-up across school, focusing on Reading, Writing and Maths

Children will be arranged into their new classes predominantly according to age, however I will also be taking into account a number of other factors including personalities, mix of characters, trying to separate siblings and gender mix (please note: not ability) Children will work in their new classes all day on the 16<sup>th</sup> July so it is essential on that day that anyone showing Covid 19 symptoms stays home and takes a PCR test to eliminate any risk.

At the beginning of September, we hope that each teacher will be able to hold an informal information event for parents after school so that you can be fully informed.

## Covid-19 Update

Thankfully, we have received further clarification from the Government that school bubbles will be discontinued and that under 18s no longer need to isolate from 16<sup>th</sup> August. We will bear this in mind when devising our "Managing Outbreaks" plan and risk assessments for September.

We will be glad to see many restrictions lifted in school from September however the new ways of doing things gave us opportunities to look at systems afresh:

- Our early morning arrangements will continue with children being dropped at the school gate between 8.40 and 8.50 as we think this provides children with a more efficient entry to school and into their classrooms.
- We will continue with our enhanced hygiene procedures to support the health and safety of all.
- We will encourage air flow through classrooms by opening windows and internal doors.
- Lunchtimes will be slightly staggered so that children don't have to line up and wait for lunches as long.
- Children will continue to have a PE afternoon where they come in PE uniform all day. Please ensure therefore that children have <u>navy blue or black</u> joggers/leggings, PE t-shirt, trainers and their school jumper/cardigan when you look at new uniform, for this day. We will let you know details of class days in due course.
