Class 1

In class we had a wonderful time learning about animals in their habitats. We drew pictures of where animals live in the wild and talked about what was happening to habitats due to environmental issues. Class 2

In Class 2 we had a brilliant day not only producing fantastic art and design work but also learning all about the world and what we can do to help save our planet. We used our artistic skills to draw images of what our world should look like and we used recycled plastic bottles to make bird feeders.



Class 3

In Class 3 we started the day by looking at the negative impact humans are having on our planet. We then created work showing what environmental impact we are having and wrote about why we need to stop.



Class 4

In class 4 we started our day by thinking about recycling and then went outside to create our own pictures using items we found outside. After this we thought about the negative human impact on the planet and what we can do about it. To show this we drew self portraits with thought bubbles to show what we think is wrong with the world and then one with what we would like the world to be like. Class 5
