Class 1

We also had lots of fun with learning Flamenco dancing and completing some gymnastics!



Class 2

Our country was Greece. We had a fun filled day researching and finding out all about ancient Greek history, including Greek jugs and the Olympics. We learnt that Greece was the first place to host an Olympic competition which included chariot racing and running. We also used an atlas to locate Greece on a world map. We particularly enjoyed Greek dancing and gymnastics in the sunshine!









Class 3

Class 3 jetted off to South America to learn all about our country-Brazil. We used atlases to find out where it is and also learnt about the countries that it borders. We discussed the physical and human features of Brazil.

Then we went outside to take part in the gymnastics competition and learnt some Brazilian carnival dancing in groups. We had a great time! In the afternoon, we created a timeline of the World Cup and pinpointed when Brazil had won it. Finally, we made and presented posters

about everything we had learned.







Class 4
