
# Class News

In the lesson of Music, class 4 learnt how to make music from only their body, they have not been using any instruments over the last half term. During RE, the class learnt about pilgrimages all over the world. This included; the Western Wall, also known as the Wailing Wall, for Jews, Mecca for Muslims and Bethlehem for Christians. In PSHCE, they were taught about staying safe and relationships. In PE, year 4 went swimming, whereas the year 5's learnt dance. A year 4 student, Scarlett, said,

# Class 5

In Literacy, we have looked at stories with a historical setting. With a focus mainly on Oliver Twist by Charles Dickens, we re-wrote parts of the famous novel.

In Maths, we have learnt a range of new concepts including statistics, perimeter, area, decimals and percentages.

During Science, Year 6 have learnt about 'Living things and space' and Year 5 have learnt about 'Sound'

In Geography, we have learnt about 'Climate change' and how greenhouse gases are affecting people in different parts of the world.

During RE, we have learnt about different codes for living. In PSHCE, we have been thinking about how to lead a healthy lifestyle.

In DT and Art, we have been planning to make an electric steady hand game and looking at the work of different artists and their particular style.

In Computing, we explored 3D modelling using a programme called Tinkercad. We also looked at programming a game.

## Class 1

In Maths Year 1 have learnt about Place Value to 50, Length and Height along with Mass and Volume. Reception have learnt about Length and Height, Place Value and 3D Shapes.
