Please find below the results of our parent survey taken place in March 2019 (86 responses - due to rounding, results may not equal 100%).



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We were delighted that there were some extremely positive comments. They really do mean a lot to myself and my colleagues who I know put in a great deal of time and effort to ensure the very best for our children.



On the whole, there was just one key issue brought up by more than one parent – homework. Unfortunately this was conflicting depending upon personal preference

• Some parents felt there was too much homework or it was too difficult:-

"I feel [my child] sometimes struggles with the volume of homework"

"Some homework [my child] receives seems too advanced"

OR

• Others felt that there was too little homework or it was not hard enough

"I would like some homework for [other subjects] as well..."

"[Would like] harder homework in some subjects"

Due to this discrepancy, I aim to send out a separate Homework survey to complement our Homework strategy in school and support learning at home.

There were specific comments which appeared to be pertinent to certain children/families. I urge these parents to contact class teacher/myself if they continue to have concerns so these can be dealt with on an individual basis.
