Curriculum Enrichment - £2700 - Contribution towards the salary of a Community Development Worker - Wide range of extra- curricular opportunity (lunchtimes and after school) for children to develop social skills alongside skills in various sports, arts and activities that will enhance life skills. Increase in participation shows that 87% of children accessed this enrichment.

Teaching and learning Intervention - £5400 - Employment of CSA to carry out 3 afternoons of focused intervention support per week - Children involved in the groups are primarily pupil premium children but not exclusively so. Interventions are solely dependent on the needs of the children concerned and this year included: Maths programmes for Years 3, 4 and 5, Reading comprehension support and Writing boosters for Key Stage 2. Employment of an additional LTS to supervise Reading Buddies and additional maths activities - School tracking process shows eligible groups of pupils making good and outstanding progress after additional teaching through intervention programmes and support.

Extended Learning Activity - £300 - Employment of a Teacher to lead Level 6 extension activities for Maths as a before school activity for a group of Year 6s - All children achieved a Level 6 in maths within the group which contained Pupil Premium and non Pupil Premium children.

Digital technology - £3300 - <u>Purchase of technology used to provide motivational activities for intervention lessons and to support children without access to IT or Internet at home</u> - School tracking process shows eligible groups of pupils making good and outstanding progress after additional teaching through intervention programmes and support. Children involved in the groups are primarily Pupil Premium children but not exclusively so.

It is very difficult to assess which of our initiatives has had specific impact in areas of learning for our Pupil Premium children. All of our Pupil Premium children have been party to Quality First Teaching, which includes school wide implementations of new changes focused on securing the best for our children, as well as some or all of the initiatives identified above.

In overall terms, the children over the year have made outstanding progress in both Key Stage 1 and 2 with the following average point's progress by area:

Reading 4.7 points progress Writing 4.1 points progress Maths 4.5 points progress
