Learning	
English	<p>Reception Our English work will include recapping our Phase 3 phonics sounds focusing on digraphs and trigraphs. We will also be learning phase 4 tricky words. Using our phonics knowledge, we will sound words out carefully to write short sentences with finger spaces. We will continue to focus on our letter formation, the size of our letters and sitting our letters on the lines.</p>
	<p>Year 1 Our English work will include reading stories such as Oliver's Vegetables and We're Going on a Bear Hunt. We will continue to develop our understanding of capital letters and full stops to ensure we are using them accurately and independently. We will also develop our vocabulary, including WOW words in our sentences.</p>
Mathematics	<p>In Maths, we are following the White Rose Maths scheme of work. Reception will be working on building numbers to 20; addition and subtraction, sharing and grouping, manipulating, composing and decomposing shapes. We will continue to develop our understanding of numbers to 10 including number bonds and one more and one less. 	<p>In Year 1, the children will be working on multiplication and division, fractions, position and direction, place value within 100, money and time. You can find out more here: https://whiteroseeducation.com/parent-pupil-resources/maths/home-learning?year=year-1-new</p>
Science	<i>The topics for science this term are Animals including Humans and Living Things and Their Habitats.</i>
Geography	<i>This half term, we will answer the key question: How does Kampong Ayer compare with where I live?</i>
Creative	<i>In DT, we will complete a unit titled Food: Fruit and Vegetables. In art, we will be looking at painting and mixed media.</i>
RE	<i>In RE we are going to learn about how and why we care for others and who brought messages out God. Reception will learn about what we can see in our wonderful world and who is special to us.</i>
P.E	<i>Across the term, the children will take part in multi-skills and athletics.</i>
PSHE	<i>In PSHE we will be looking at citizenship.</i>
Computing	<i>Our main focus within computing this term is grouping data and programming a moving robot.</i>
Music	<i>Within music we will cover pitch and tempo and look at musical stories. Then we will be working on vocal and body sounds.</i>
History	<i>In History we will be learning about Grace Darling.</i>

It is important that we continue to develop our reading skills; working on reading fluently at a good speed, asking questions and answering comprehension questions about a text.
