## Learning

English	<p>This half term, we will be looking at many different narratives including fairy tales and tradition tales. We will be writing our own poetry, narratives and writing some recounts about what we did at the weekend. Reception children will continue to use their phonetic knowledge to sound words out carefully to write sentences. Year 1 children will continue to use full stops, capital letters and begin to use conjunctions, such as and, to join short sentences.</p> <p>In our phonics sessions, we use the Little Wandle Letters and Sounds scheme. We will then continue onto Phase 4 to read short vowels, longer words and compound words.</p> <p><b>Year 1</b> Phonics- We will review phase 5 and prepare for the phonics screening.</p>

<b>Our Topic this term is: Enterprise!</b>	
Science	<i>In science, we are going to learn about seasonal changes and the weather. We will investigate how much rain falls over 5 weeks.</i>
Topic	<i>We are very excited to start our enterprise task this half term. We are going to make a product to sell and learn all about profit.</i>
Creative	<i>We are going to use our sketching skills to draw portraits of Queen Elizabeth II. We will display these during our enterprise.</i>
RE	<i>In RE, our big question is- Who brought messages about God and what did they say?</i>
P.E	<i>The pupils will be working on multi skills. This involves running, throwing and jumping to improve agility, balance and coordination.</i>
PSHE	<i>In PSHE, our topic is economic wellbeing. This includes looking at money, banks, how we look after our money and different jobs.</i>
Computing	<i>We are going to learn all about how we can group data. We will look at data bases and how they group data to make it easily accessible.</i>
Music	<i>We are going to use familiar stories to learn rhyme and rhythm. We will use different musical instruments during our music lessons.</i>
