Learning	
English	Class 3 will look at and study a variety of texts and books. We will use these text types to compose our own writing linked to develop our narrative writing skills as well as completing reading and SPAG activities this term. In guided reading we will be studying a range of texts and focusing on fiction and poetry. In addition, we will write our own fantasy stories and discussion texts. As the term develops our English work will focus around the following text types: poetry, stories with a dilemma and lesson and non-chronological report. We will work on comprehension skills and using grammar through our writing. We will work hard to make sure we are joining our writing, spellings and punctuation.
Mathematics	This term we shall develop our knowledge of measure, statistics and shape including: money, weight, length and triangles and quadrilaterals. We will develop our mental strategies for addition and subtraction as well as our multiplication and division facts during our fluent in five sessions. This will help us as we work with written calculations. We will continue to work on knowing all our times tables- it is really important we get them mastered this year particularly for year 4 as during this term they will be completing a multiplication check. We will do lots of work at school but any practise at home would be greatly appreciated. We will be continuing using a new maths scheme called White Rose Maths to really deepen our understanding and embed key knowledge.
